

Basic information in English about the State Stud Celle's online horse auctions

This is simply a short summary of our terms and conditions for the online horse auctions to reach out to our international customers to give them the opportunity to participate. It is not a complete translation of the auction's terms and conditions. The purchase agreements are based on the full German version.

The State Stud Celle organizes this online auction. The horses (catalog no. 2, 3, 5, 7, 8, 10, 12, and 14) are sold by the Hengstaufzuchtgestüt Hunnesrück, therefore the purchase agreement will be conducted between the buyer and the Hengstaufzuchtgestüt Hunnesrück. Catalog no. 1, 4, 6, 9, 11 and 13 are sold by the State Stud Celle, purchase agreement will be conducted between the buyer and the State Stud Celle. All agreements between organizer, seller and buyer to fulfill the purchase agreement are based on the (original) Auktionsbedingungen (terms and conditions). All bidders accept these terms and conditions with registration for this auction.

How to participate

In order to bid all participants need to be registered at <https://bid.landgestuetcelle.de/auction>. The registration requires correct and full personal information. Please state whether you are business or private person. Incorrect or invalid given information may lead to being excluded from the auctions.

Horse information

All information about the horses can be viewed and read on the website (<https://www.landgestuetcelle.de/>). It includes the horses name, sex, year of birth, color and pedigree. All photographs and videos are a subjective description of the horse. It does not contain any guarantee for its quality or condition. All horses have been "used" by means of that they have been trained age appropriately for this auction, therefore they are offered as "used" animals.

All horses have been clinically examined by our veterinarians. 16 radiographs of each horse (limbs) are available. There is no medical protocol, please contact your own vet or clinical professional at your own expense to have the exams and x-rays interpreted. You cannot bid, unless you acknowledge that you did check out the x-rays, inspected and tried the horse personally or by your representatives.

All horses are stabled in Spörckenstr. 10 in 29221 Celle. Please make an appointment for a trial in advance.

The Auction

The auctions starts with an offer on the State Stud Celle's website. It is explained when the auctions starts and the offer will last until the end of the stated bidding time. The remaining time for this offer will be shown at the right hand corner of the screen. In the last 3 minutes of bidding time a new bid will lengthen the bidding time by another three minutes. If there is no other bid, the auctions for this offer ends at this point. The lengthening of bidding times due to bidding activity will not affect any other bidding times on other offers. All stated money amounts are in Euro currency. An offer starts with 2.000,00€ as minimum bid. The next higher bid must be at least 200,00€ higher than the prior bid. You may enter a bid as high as you wish. You will be informed by email and via the auction platform that your bid got accepted and if there is a higher bid than yours.

Prior to bidding you have to unlock the entry mask on your screen by pressing a button in order to enter an amount in the box "Gebot in Zahlen". The highest bid at the end of the bidding time will be the buyer of the horse. The buyer will be notified by email.

Terms of Payment

There will be charged an additional auction fee of 2,5% to all final auction prices (of the final price) and German VAT. The seller Hengstaufzuchtgestüt Hunnesrück (catalog no 2, 3, 5, 7,

8, 10, 12, and 14) will add 19% VAT to the final price. The State Stud Celle does not add any VAT according to local tax regulations (catalog no. 1, 4, 6, 9, 11 and 13). If the horse is supposed to leave Germany you must obtain a vet health certificate at the County Veterinarian of Celle at your own expense. If the horse is supposed to leave the European Union a customs declarations is also needed (additional fees may apply).

If the horse is not being paid for after 7 business days (including Saturday), the seller may withdrawal from the purchase agreement. In that case the horse may be sold to a third party and the former buyer may have to compensate any reduced proceeds that might arise compared to the earlier auction.

The horse will remain in full ownership of the seller until the invoiced amount is paid completely. The risk is being passed as soon as the purchase agreement is concluded.

Pick up and Ownership

The ownership will be transferred after the invoiced amount is paid by the buyer. The horse has to be picked up as soon as possible after payment. If the horse is not being picked up within 7 days after the auction date, the buyer must pay a stabling fee of 22,00€ per day. If the horse is not being picked up within 14 days after the auction date, the seller may withdrawal from the purchase agreement and reimburse the buyer.
